



The 2023 Off-Road Series Club Challenge

USATF Mid-Atlantic clubs can compete for cash awards in the 2023 Off-Road Series. Teams will be comprised of USATF Mid-Atlantic members affiliated with the club. MAUSATF will track participation and tabulate the results.

RULES:

- ❖ Any **2023 USATF Mid-Atlantic Association Club** is eligible to field a team.
- ❖ Runners identify their club team affiliation when they submit their individual USATF membership for 2023. Team members must be registered USATF Mid-Atlantic members *before* the event in which they are participating in order to be scored AND have club affiliation in place *before* the event in order to score for a team. Registrations are done online at usatf.org.
- ❖ *Unattached* runners who have already registered for 2023 should notify the USATF Mid-Atlantic membership chair in writing if they wish to be affiliated with a club. This can be an email to membership@midatlantic.usatf.org
- ❖ USATF rules concerning club changes will be observed - a 90-day waiting period is required. Any change to a member's club affiliation must be requested and processed by Mid-Atlantic USATF membership services, membership@midatlantic.usatf.org
- ❖ Team scoring for each event will be the total of up to 5 club members with the highest age-graded scores, using the 2020 WMA tables. For 4 or 5 runners to score, at least 1 must be female. (All scoring runners may be female.)
- ❖ Team scores for the series will be the total of the clubs best 6 of 9 events in 2023 (Three lowest scores are dropped). If any event is canceled due to severe weather or public health issues, the number of scores to total will be adjusted (3 lowest scores of races actually held will be dropped).
- ❖ Year end cash awards: 1st - \$650, 2nd - \$500, 3rd - \$400, 4th - \$300, 5th - \$200. In order to qualify for a cash award, a club must compete and score in at least 4 of the 9 races in the series.
- ❖ The USATF Mid-Atlantic Off-Road Club Challenge is a separate competition not affiliated with the host race's team competition, if any. See the LDR/Off Road pages on our website at mausatf.org for more information.
