The Mid-Atlantic Association accomplished a tremendous amount this past year. We successfully delivered three Youth Championship races, fourteen Long Distance Running (LDR) Grand Prix races, nine Off-Road races, Open and Masters Cross Country Championships, and a joint Open and Masters Track & Field Championship with the New Jersey Association. We also saw continued membership growth, increased revenue and reduced expenses.

These accomplishments position us well for a very busy and successful 2026, and I'm excited to build on this momentum together.

I was recently appointed Interim Association President. While this is my 30th year serving the Association, primarily through the LDR Committee, I have spent the past six years as Membership and Sanctions Chair, working closely with all committees as well as many members, clubs, coaches and event organizers across the region. That experience has given me a deep appreciation for the dedication and collaboration that make our Association strong.

We now head into one of our busiest stretches in more than eight years. Between now and the end of July, we will be hosting two Youth Track & Field meets, the Region II Junior Olympics meet, an Open and Masters meet (local), and at least twelve LDR events. To make all this possible, we will be relying on the continued support of our members: through participation, volunteering (particularly in the Bethlehem/Moravian University area), and engagement at our events.

Thank you for everything you do to support the Mid-Atlantic Association. The Mid-Atlantic Association Officers and I look forward to seeing many of you at our meets and events in the months ahead and to another outstanding year together.

YOUTH COMMITTEE (Chair: Nelson Berrios)

As noted above, the USATF Mid-Atlantic Youth Committee has a very busy year ahead. We will kick off the season with our **Youth Indoor Track & Field Championships at Alvernia University in Reading, PA, on January 18**. This will be followed by our **Association Junior Olympic Outdoor Championships**, a two-day meet hosted at **Moravian University** in Bethlehem, PA, **on June 6 and 7**. We will then host the **Region II Junior Olympic Championships**, a four-day meet bringing together athletes from the Mid-Atlantic, New Jersey, Three Rivers, and Niagara Associations, at **Moravian University from July 9 through July 12**.

Registration for all Youth events will be handled through Athletic.net. We anticipate the USATF National Office announces the Junior Olympic National Championship location in a couple weeks.

I would also like to take a moment to congratulate our **2025 Youth Athletes of the Year**. These outstanding athletes advanced from the Association Junior Olympic Championships to the Region II Junior Olympic Championships, where they placed, and went on to finish in the top 10 percent at the USATF National Junior Olympic Championships. Their performances reflect both exceptional talent and the strength of our Youth Clubs and programs. The awards luncheon will be on Sunday, February 15 at the Reading High School. Additional details will be communicated to our coaches and families shortly.

2025 Highlights

- 216 athletes, 335 events at the Outdoor Open & Masters Championships (+133% vs. 2024)
- Successful partnership with USATF New Jersey to deliver a high-quality championship meet
- Congratulations to the Greater Philadelphia Track Club - who won both Masters and Open division team awards
- Expanded visibility through sponsored and partnered local PA meets, strengthening the regional competitive pipeline

We are proud to recognize **Michelle Rohl (Greater Philadelphia Track Club)** as our **2025 High Performance Athlete of the Year!!**

Michelle delivered an extraordinary season - winning World Championship titles indoors (800m, 1500m, 3000m), setting three American Records, and earning U.S. indoor titles across those events. Outdoors, she added a national championship and world-best mile (5:09.7) and a 10,000m world record (36:32.32).
